- Has the right to be heard
- Has the right to speak freely and openly without prejudice

- Has the right to communicate with other groups
- Has the right to attend and be involved in sub-committee meetings
- Has the right to visit the school with agreement
- Has a responsibility to promote the college and to maintain confidence and confidentiality
