



ICD Declaration of Rights

Parents' rights

- Right to expect that their child's educational needs are met and that their child is safe and looked after physically and pastorally
- Right to expect their child to be given equal opportunities regardless of nationality, creed, gender, background or ability
- Right to request reports on their child's work and behaviour written or verbal
- Right to ask for information held about their child
- Right to limit who information is given to about their child with the exception of child protection issues
- Right to contact the College if they have any concerns about their child, ensuring that protocol and correct procedures are followed
- Right to be involved in aspects of College life through the Parent Council
- Right to information about school activities and events via the College Prospectus, annual report, newsletter, information leaflets and College website etc.
- Right to attend the Annual General Parents Meeting and elect Parent Governors and Parent Council Officers
- Right to expect that homework is given according to the guidelines of the College and the Departmental Homework Policies. As such, parents have a responsibility to support and encourage completion of the same. In ensuring that their child devotes adequate time to homework and to home study, they will therefore promote self discipline in their child and encourage them to develop their potential as independent learners.
